    - Christmas still recruiting donors for families
  - Started with asylum seekers with a luncheon
    - Heard from them that they didnt have clothing
    - Started clothing closet on second floor
    - Come several days a week

- Need men shoes sneakers coats small and med
- Womens coats small and med
- Children 8-15 size
- Will house bicycles
- Hotel gave us bike racks
- Partnered with DUPC
- Installed in back parking lot
- Within 2 weeks all were stolen
- Myra shared story next week
- Officer Moses Robinson gave back 17 bikes to group
- Decided that former placement of rack to back was not ideal
- Will move bike rack to the front and city hall will round on them 24-7
- Myra Aaron Lynch and parishioners went to Chiapas Mexico
  - Met scholarship recipients
  - Fiesta of food
  - Stayed in families homes
  - Visited coffee coop
  - Did a pastoral visit
  - Visit indigenous people
- Celebrated Haiti HOPE
  - Dr Tony went back to address charges
    - Charges were dropped
  - Mary Magdalene hosted HOPE coffee hour
  - HOPE ALive concert
- Lauren and volunteers lead a youth retreat
  - Invest supports youth ministry
  - Theme modern day discipleship
    - What does it mean to be a disciple
    - What does it take to be a disciple
    - Who are modern day disciple

  - Mission increase access to mh care who don't have insurance or who have other reason
  - Offer one on one and peer support

    - Referred by people who are with them currently
  - On third floor at DUPC but spread all over
  - 3 paid staff Amy Durkee MArk Potter and Eileen Hurley
  - 12 volunteer license therapist
  - 3 peer support who work in the group
  - 1 peer support specialist meets people in community
  - Yoga teacher
  - About \$72000 in donated services
  - Saw 204 people increase from last year
  - Group they run for survivors of sexual assault will offer again in Jan 4 weeks with an additional 2 week add on
    - Day and time is not advertised
  - Quotes From survey

- You folks really listen I'm scared of most people and that makes me not want to ask for help but you listen and that makes me glad
- I believe that i wouldn't be receiving any care without your kind and caring staff
- Eileen
  - Meet mostly with young people
  - Sometimes barriers are family situation
  - Not comfortable with the mental health center
  - Supervising Mark getting his MSW
  - Gun violence survivors 14-30 all young men disadvantaged difficult home
  - Gunshot wounds rendered them paralyzed
  - Trying to find an affordable wheelchair apt when you have a criminal record is very difficult
  - Rochester Spinal association partnership
    - Very intensive work
    - Meet people in hospital at home
    - She doesn't know who else would be helping these people
    - Living in homes they can't get out of because of stairs
  - Questions
    - How did the walk go
      - Awesome
      - More poorly attended
      - Breast Cancer walk was same weekend as ours
      - Goal was \$30,000 was at \$29,500
      - Beautiful event
- Invest in SpiritUS campaign
  - Myra spoke about finances and how collection had been flat lined as an average
  - Got standing ovation

- Talked about everything that is going on at parish
- Slides
- People we are able to serve
- Spiritus is a place where we have our arms spread out for people
- 40 people have started or increased automatic deduction
- Do there own through their bank
- Others put Spiritus in their wills
- Lots of ways to give
- Got nice notes form people along the way
- Note
  - Use this money wherever most needed we trust the staff
  - We took a look at where we spend our money and we will increase \$25 week
  - Whatever we give will never measure the bounty we receive from this parish
- Have had people say they can
- T right now but will infuture
- One person said they like writing check as they think about tithing
